Directions: Setup a station in your classroom with CHATGPT window open.

Log into the computer using Username: .\weclient **Password:** weclient

Give your classroom tutor a name Mine is named "Einstein"

If you are busy working with other students, direct your students to use "Einstein".

Example:

Prompt: 6th graders will ask you questions about how to solve a math problem. After students type in their questions, show them how to solve the equation without giving the answer. Give them a similar problem to solve on their own.
